

Report on Year 7 Parent Questionnaire November 2017

Our parent questionnaire is based on Parent View, an online questionnaire used by Ofsted to gather the views of parents/carers on their child's school. As well as incorporating questions from Parent View our questionnaire invites feedback on transition from primary school, spiritual, moral and faith development.

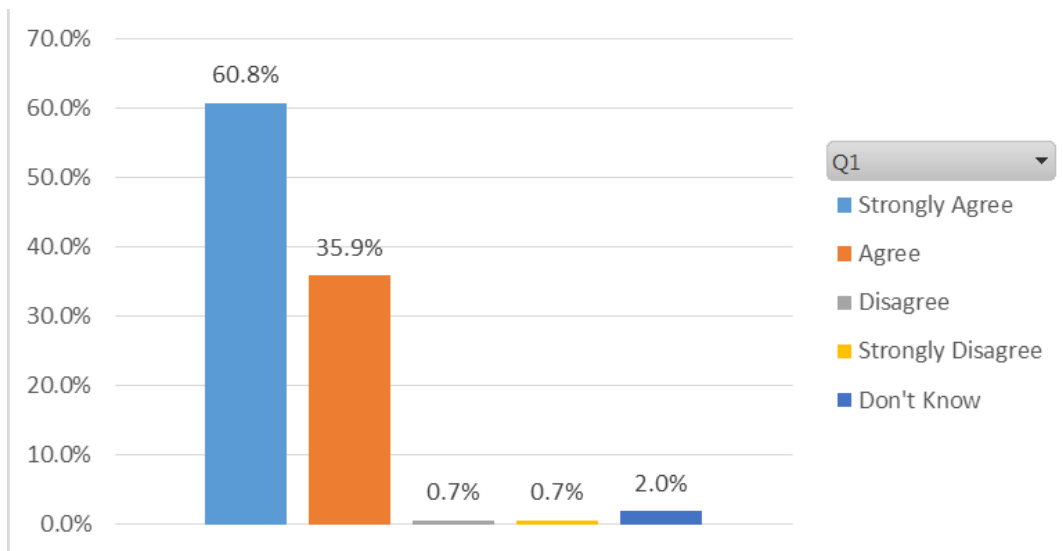
65% of families (153 returns from 237 families) responded to this questionnaire.

The questionnaire provides parents with the opportunity to expand on any responses to questions. The school has followed up on all such queries directly with parents.

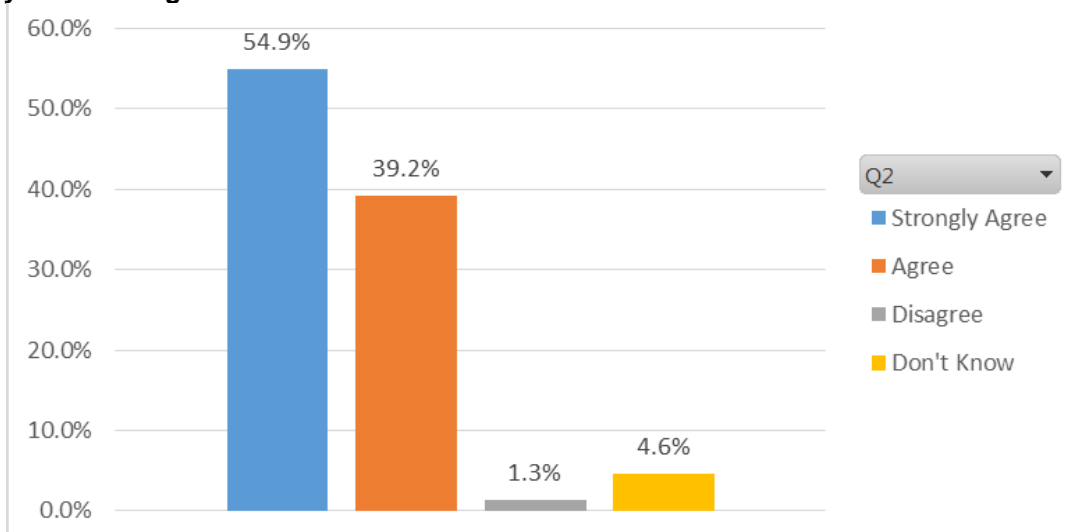
The results of the survey are summarised below. Overall parent satisfaction remains extremely high.

(The views of one family represents 0.65%. Note the total % may not be 100% due to rounding up the figures).

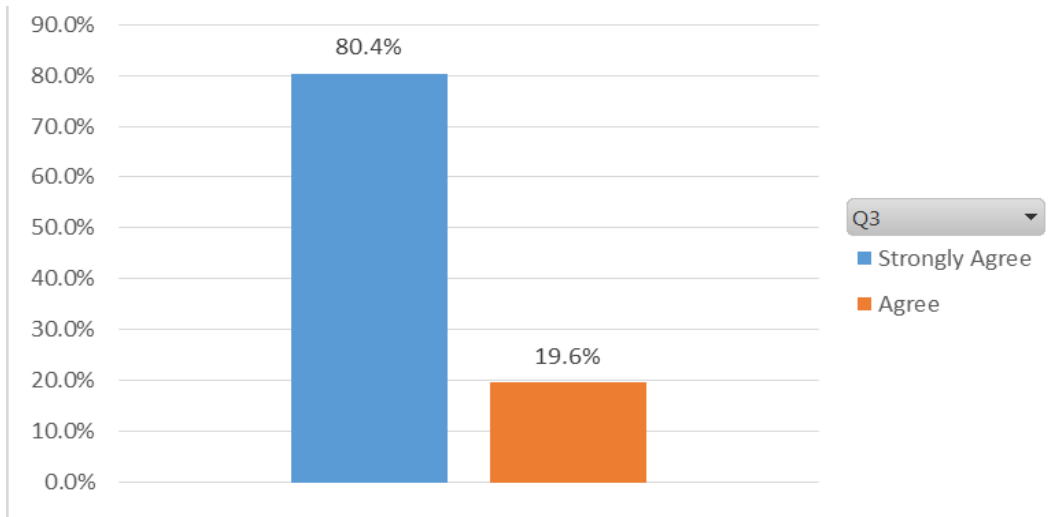
Q1. My child is happy at this school.



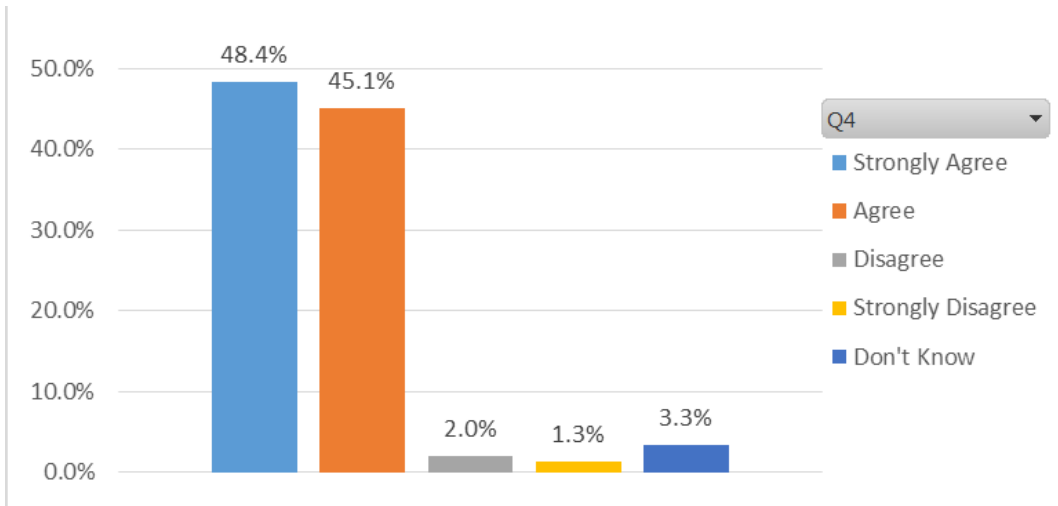
Q2. My child is taught well at this school.



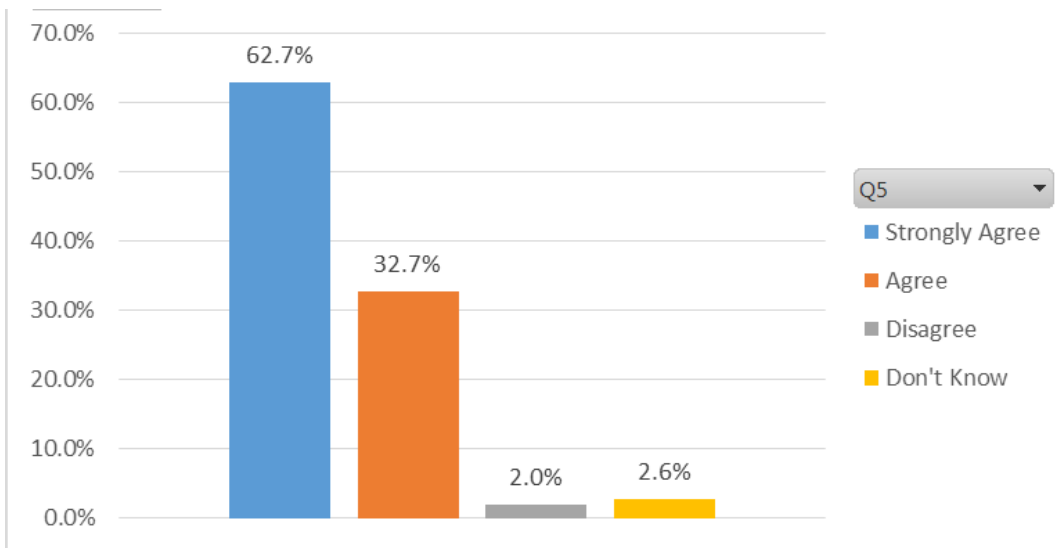
Q3. The school expects my child to work hard and do his or her best.



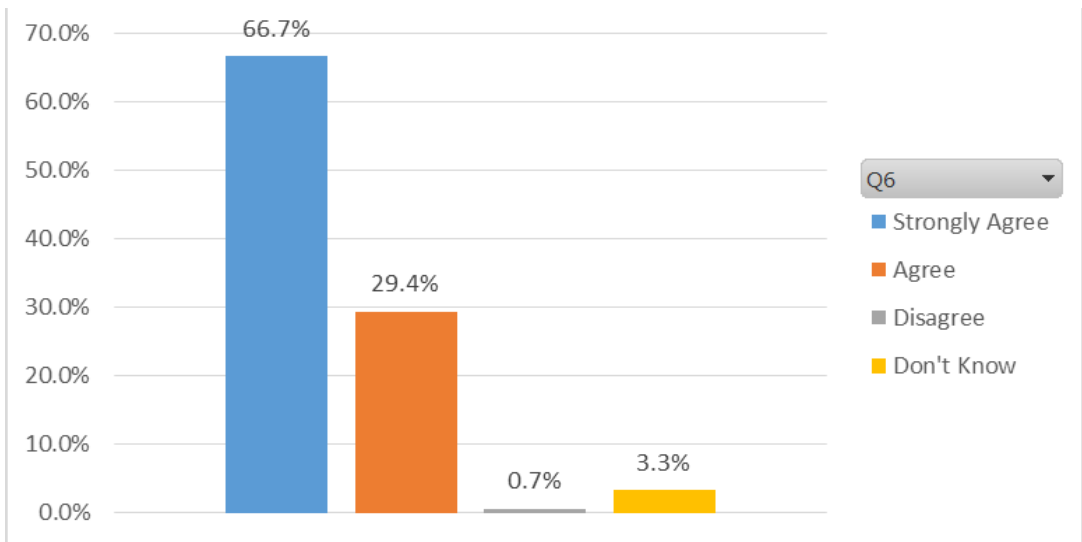
Q4. My child receives appropriate homework for their age.



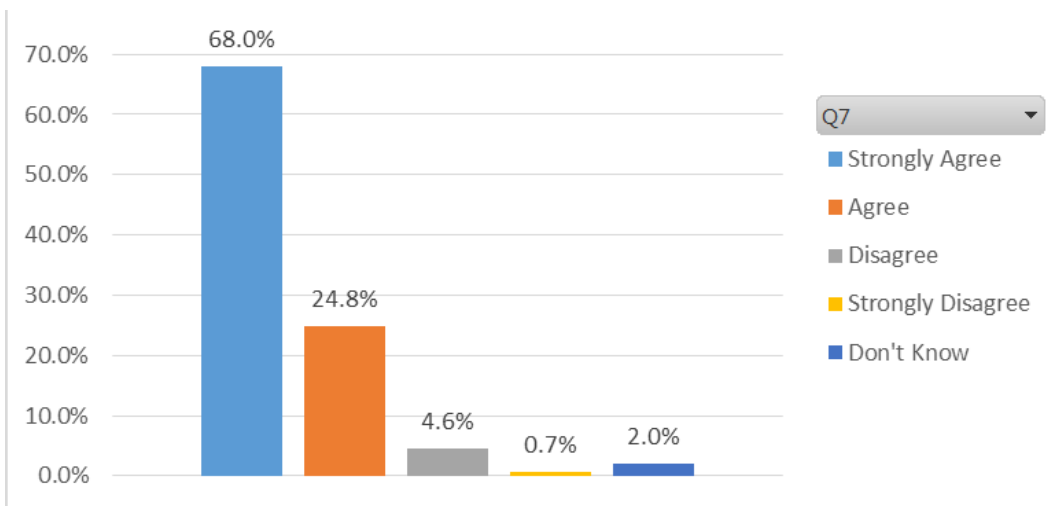
Q5. My child is well looked after at this school.



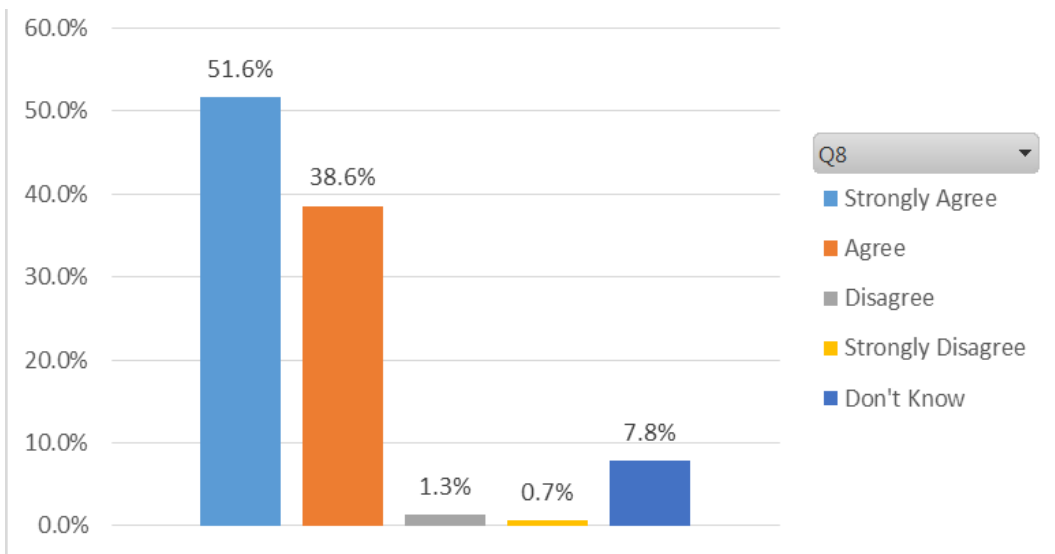
Q6. This school helps my child to develop skills in communication, reading, writing and mathematics.



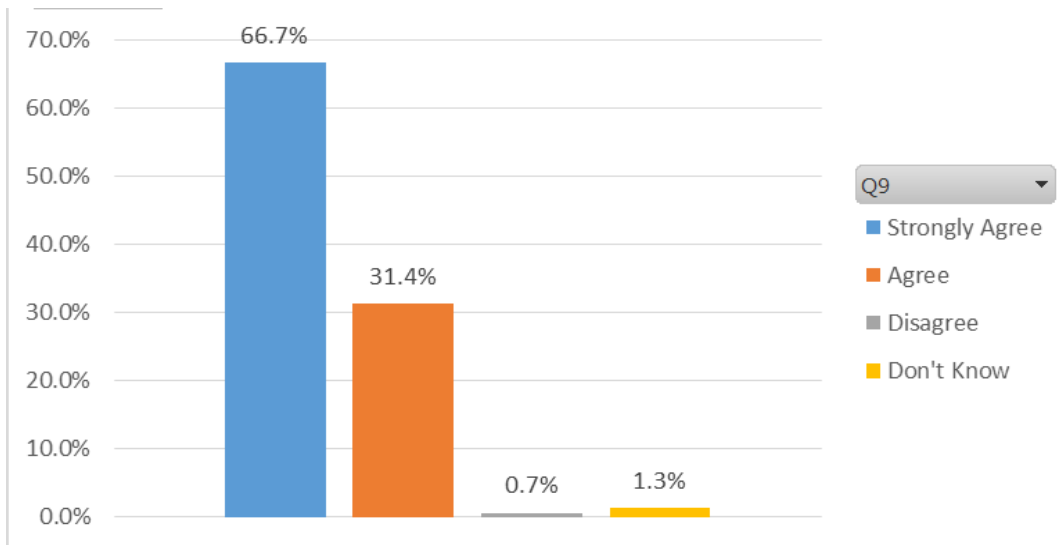
Q7. My child had a smooth and successful transition from primary school.



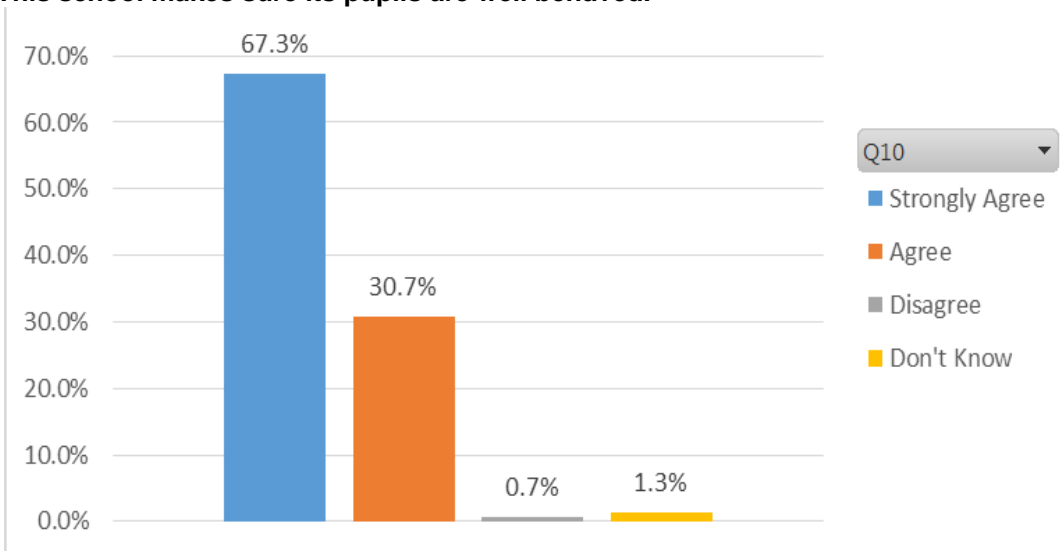
Q8. This school helps me to support my child's learning.



Q9. My child feels safe at this school.

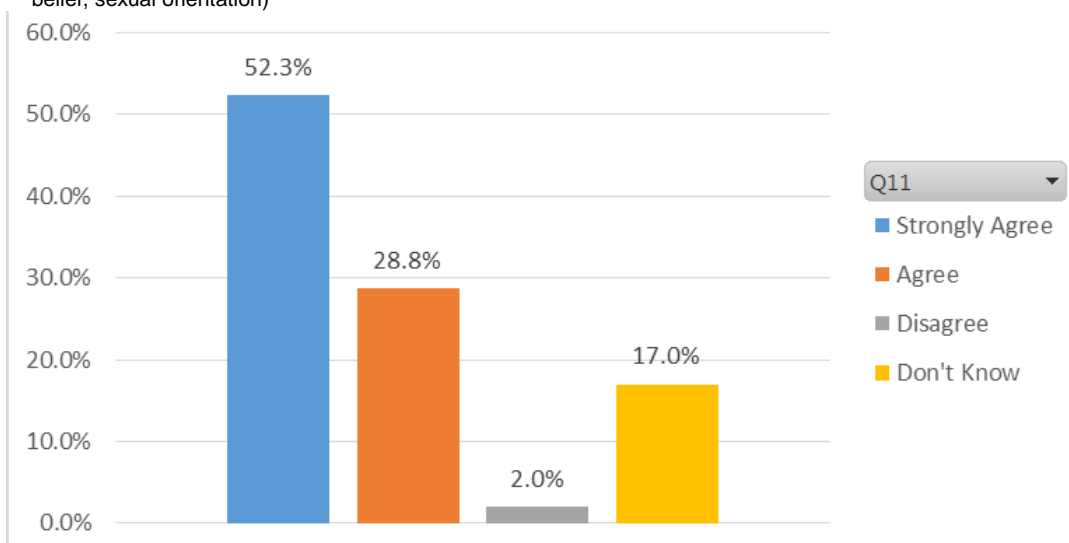


Q10. This school makes sure its pupils are well behaved.

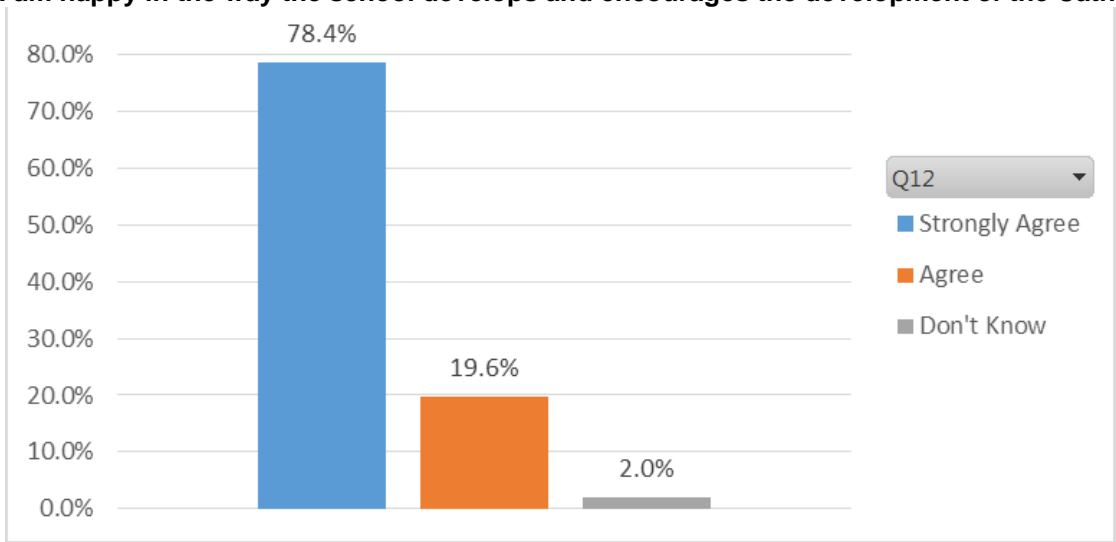


Q11. This school has effective provision for both preventing and dealing with bullying.

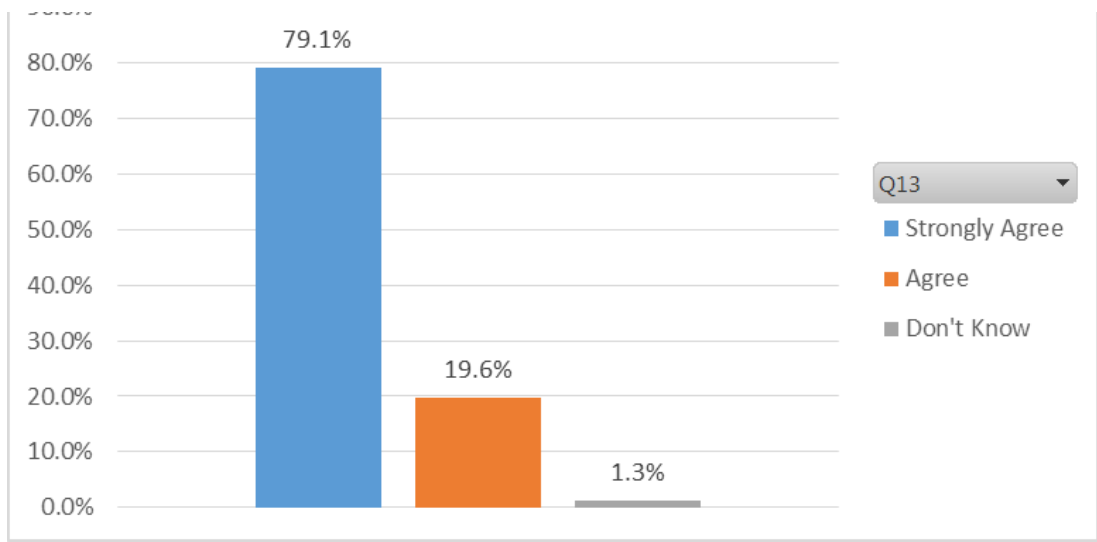
(Bullying includes persistent name calling, cyber and matters relating to race, disability, gender, gender reassignment, religion or belief, sexual orientation)



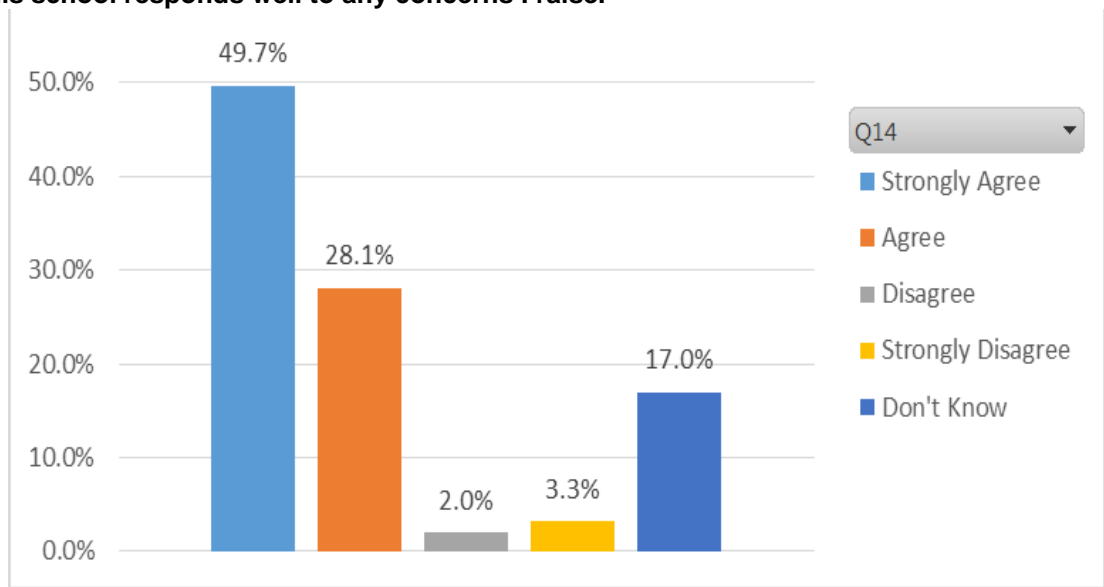
Q12. I am happy in the way the school develops and encourages the development of the Catholic faith.



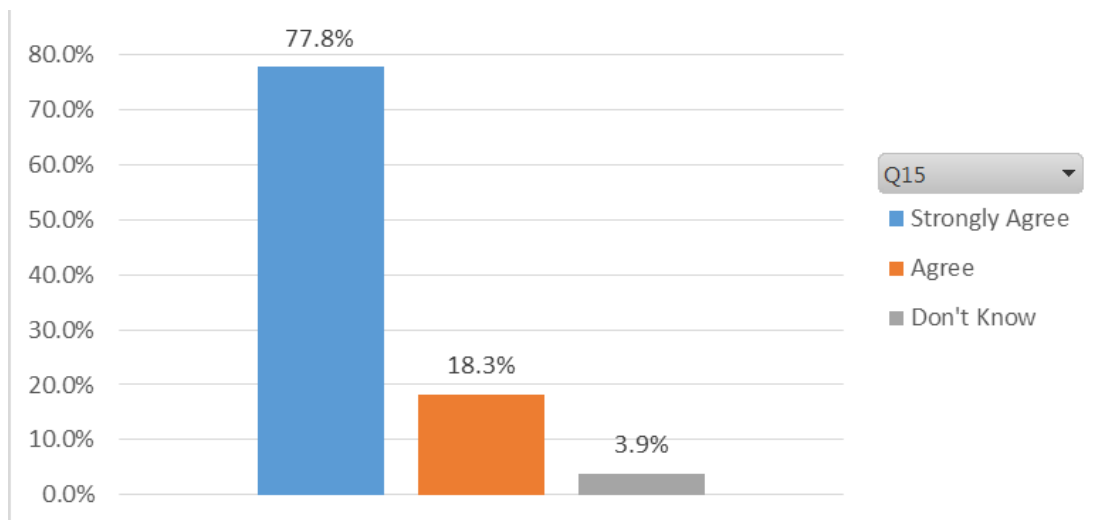
Q13. This school provides well for the moral and spiritual development of my child.



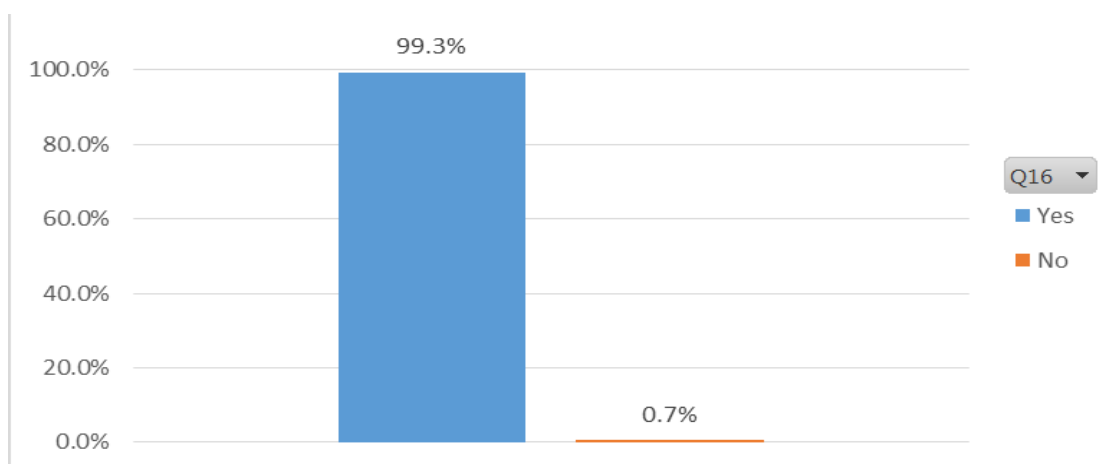
Q14. This school responds well to any concerns I raise.

Parent Comments
