## Curricular Activities

Here is a selection of the activities that have taken place

Art: The Royal Academy of Art visited the Art dept. and ran a one day 'Life Class'.

Science: Year 9 Students are taking part in the Redbridge Science Technology Day

Drama: students are taking part in LAMDA which develops their skills further in all aspects of the subject.

Maths: KS3 take part in a national Maths Challenge.
