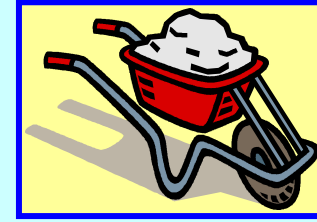

Controlled Assessments

This qualification is awarded through continuous monitoring of practical work and end of unit examinations. Students will need to pass a number of credits in order to gain the award.

Students are given full details of the assessment criteria at the start of each unit. Students practice the tasks required for each unit then provide several pieces of practical work which are photographed and have documented evidence for the external moderator to assess. Assessment is on a pass/ fail basis.

Students who do not pass a unit will be given time to improve their skills and knowledge and they can then re-take that unit.
