The Controlled Assessment will be internally marked, this accounts for 25% of the GCSE.

The controlled assessment in history is a three part process. It begins with an enquiry in which students gather information upon a topic and write a source based essay on a set question. The remaining part of the controlled assessment involves looking at pictorial and written representations of the period and judging their usefulness in answering questions on the period.

Controlled assessments must be undertaken in class and cannot be completed at home.
