Year 10 USA 1919 - 1941
(25% of the total examination)**

Subject Content - Year 10 GERMANY

End of the First World War; Treaty of Versailles; 1923; Stresemann; Hitler and the Nazi Party; The Depression; Nazi electoral victory; Police State; Social policy; Opposition to the Nazis. This unit is examined at the end of Year 10 and is worth 25% of the examination.

Subject Content - Year 11 MEDICINE

Roman medicine and public health, Galen, Medieval medicine and public health - The Black Death; Renaissance medicine, Vesalius and Harvey; Industrialisation impact, vaccination, germ theory and its consequences; 20th century disease prevention – penicillin and DNA; public health before and after the NHS.

This unit is examined at the end of Year 11 and is worth 25% of the examination.

Special Topic: Transformation of Surgery 1845c - 1918c (25% of the total examination)

This is a source based unit that looks at evidence on the topic and requires responses based as much on source analysis as content knowledge.

Assessment

The homework policy at GCSE is to undertake notes, exam style essays and source evaluations which consolidate knowledge and provide practice in the extended writing skills necessary for the examination. Material will be taken from past exam papers. Reward is given to focusing upon the questions' requirements. Examination preparation will begin with revision classes in the Summer of Year 11.

Skills Developed

- The ability to understand and recall historical information.
- The ability to distinguish causes of events.
- The ability to identify information from historical sources.
- The ability to understand that sources can be interpreted from different view points.

Provision for Gifted and Talented and SEN

Students with learning needs will be identified through assessment and class work. Extension work will be available within lessons

Differentiation

Differentiation by outcome is the traditional method which the department employs to encompass mixed ability teaching, as well as differentiation through the management of the lessons. This will entail oral questioning and assessment feedback to monitor the rate of an individual's progress in the lessons.

How the work in Year 10 builds on work in Year 11

Examination content continues with skills utilisation at an appropriate higher level. Literacy based skills of extended writing tasks and source investigation will continue.
