

Trinity Catholic High School A Level Results 2017

Trinity's 'A' Level students achieved outstanding results again this year. Although our 'A' Level pass rate is always high, this year's 98.9% pass rate ranks amongst our highest ever - a truly fantastic achievement.

Our main headlines are as follows:

- A* - E pass rate: 98.9%.
- A* - C pass rate: 74.7%
- A* - B pass rate: 49.6%
- A*-A pass Rate: 20.1%:

98.9% of students achieved A*-E grades at A level – an excellent achievement with results higher than the previous year. **49.6%** of students have attained the higher grades of A*-B with **5%** of entries achieving the very highest A* grade.

There were 193 students in Year 13 at the end of KS5 – **88.6%** of these students achieved at least 3 A*-E grades and **97.9%** attained at least 2 A*-E grades.

22/27, achieved 100% pass rates at A level.

The achievements of Trinity's 'A' Level students were once again above UK averages in almost every assessable category. These exam results rank with the best ever for the school. Our students have worked extremely hard and we are extremely proud of them. They deserve their success.

In all 33 Students attained AAB or above at A level, exceeding targets, which is a truly outstanding achievement.

A total of 17 students achieved either three or four A*/A grades in their A Levels. Of particular note are twins, Max and Riku Campman, both of whom achieved 4 A* grades at A level. These outstanding results have secured a place at Cambridge, to study Computer Science, for Max and one at Imperial College London for Riku, to study Aeronautical Engineering.

166 students applied for a place at a UK university this year. The process was incredibly competitive and securing a place was very challenging – especially on the

most popular courses at the most popular universities. The vast majority of Trinity students were successful in their higher education applications and almost all of these are looking forward to taking up their places in the next few weeks. Trinity leavers will be studying a wide range of subjects - from Accountancy through Medicine to Technical Theatre - and at universities the length and breadth of the UK (including Cambridge and almost every one of the Russell Group of universities). Congratulations and good luck to them all!

Not all A Level leavers have chosen to go to university – some have chosen to start employment and some have enrolled on post-‘A’ Level training programmes with local or City-based firms. We wish these students well, too!
